Developing an Architectural Research Agenda

This workshop is intended for all those who are considering a research career in architecture: researchers in the early stages, doctoral students, graduate students interested in doing a PhD, etc. Additionally, you are welcome if you are interested in discussing the architectural research processes, methods and results.
